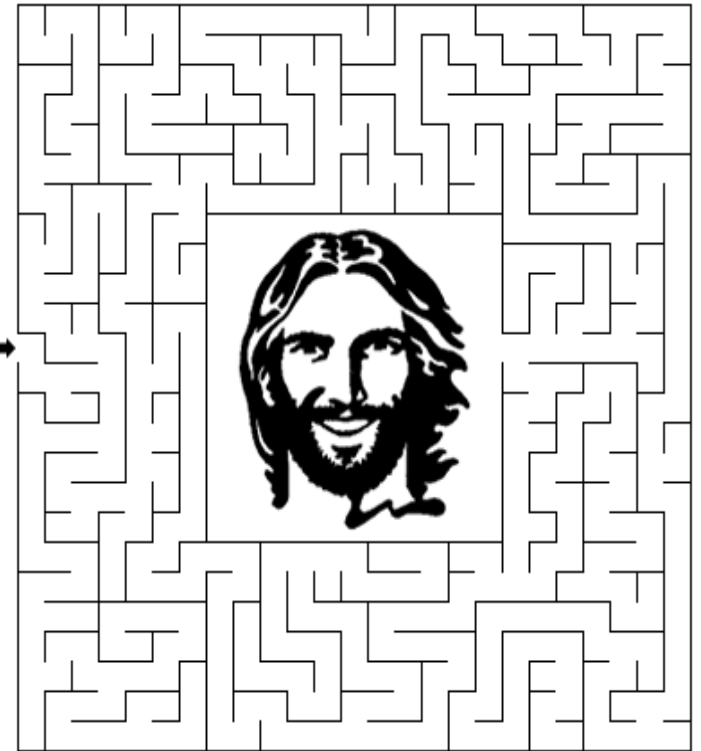

And Jesus helped the disciples to understand the Scriptures. He said to them,

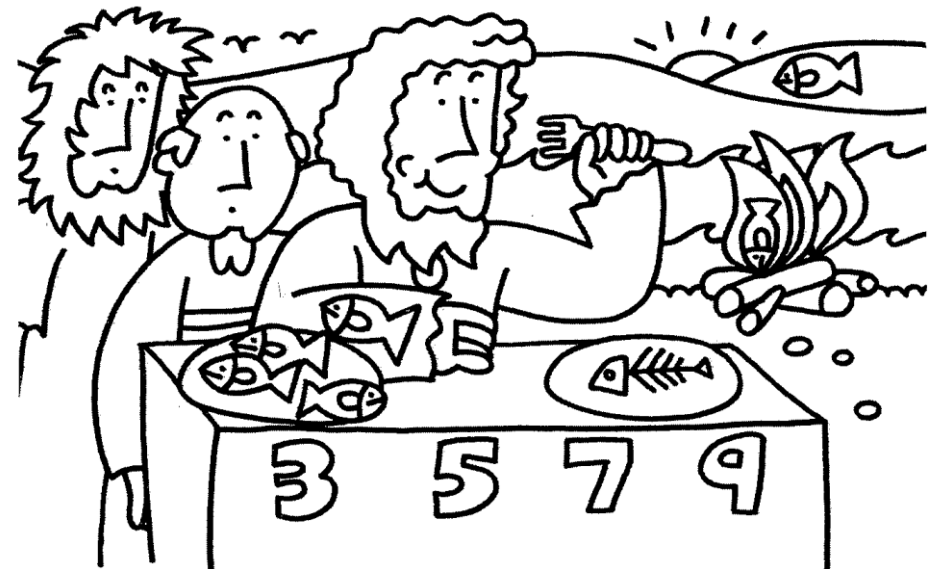
